Always walk on the footpath.




Cross the road only at the zebra crossing.



WHEN ON THE ROAD

• Before crossing the road, look to the right, then to your left and then to your right again. Now, walk across if the road is clear.

 Always cross the road with a grownup.



ALWAYS REMEMBER!

- Never run while crossing the road.
- Remember the rules while travelling to school in a bus/van.
- Stand in a line while waiting for the bus.
- Get in or out off the bus only after the bus/van or any other vehicle has stopped moving.
- Never stick your head or arms out of the window of the vehicle. You can get hit by a passing vehicle.



SAFETY RULES WHEN YOU PLAY

 Every game has its rules. Following the rules is good for everyone. Everyone will enjoy the game and also be safe.

Do not fight.

 Do not hurt each other while playing.

 Play in a safe place. Play in a park or a garden or at home





SAFETY RULES WHEN YOU SWIM

Always go to the pool with a grown-up.

Do not play rough games in the pool.

Always take a rubber tube with you.

Avoid going in the deep end.





SOME MORE THINGS YOU MUST NEVER, NEVER DO

- Fire and electricity are both very useful. But, they can be very dangerous if not used properly.
- Never play with <u>matchsticks</u>, <u>electrical wires or</u> sockets.





• Knives, scissors and tools are used in every home. But, we have to be careful with them. If we are not

careful, we can get hurt.





• Ask an adult how to use them. Always use them in the presence of an adult.



BE SAFE

• When you get hurt it pains. You will not get hurt if you are careful. Other people will also not get hurt.



• IMPORTANT: If someone is hurt call a grown-up at once!






