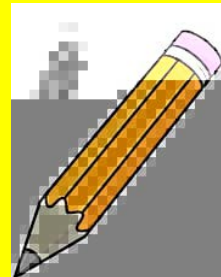


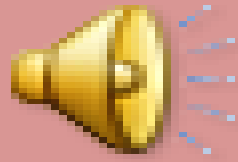


# COMMON NOUN

**FOR EXAMPLE: GIRL, PENCIL, APPLE**

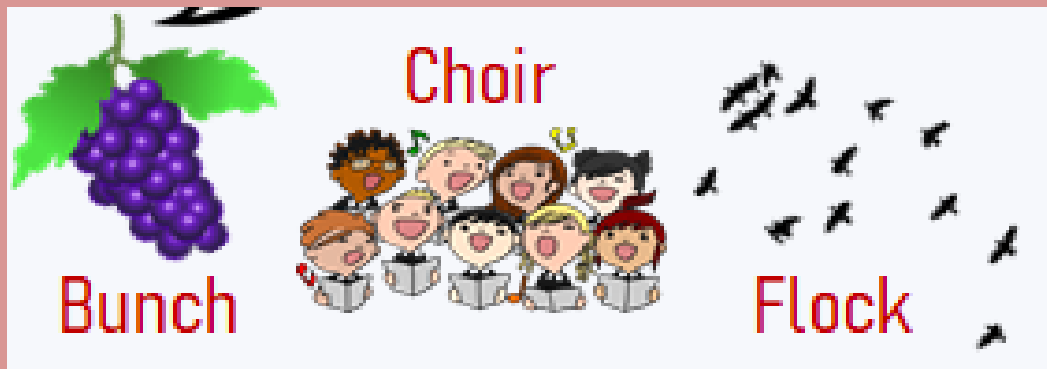




# COLLECTIVE NOUN
