



A REPORT ON THE WORKSHOP CONDUCTED BY CBSE, CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE, DELHI EAST ON “GENDER SENSITIVITY”.

Summer Fields Schools arranged a workshop for the faculty on the topic “Gender Sensitivity” with an endeavour to equip, update and empower the teachers. The workshop was conducted by CBSE, Centre of Excellence, Delhi East on Saturday, 8th April 2023 on the premises of Summer Fields School. The resource persons apprised the terms and meaning connected to 'gender' and 'sex'. The difference in these two terms, key points on gender sensitivity, case studies etc were well defined and explained. They further stressed the need to bring a shift in the mindset of society as a whole from that of a stereotype and narrow-mindedness to a wider and positive perspective when it comes to dealing with issues connected to gender.

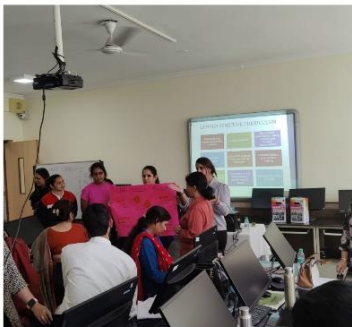
