

REPORT ON WORKSHOP

TOPIC: VALUES EDUCATION

The teachers at Summer Fields School participated in a workshop that was based on Value Education. The resource person for the workshop was Dr. Sandeep Kumar, who is a clinical psychologist, a teacher, a counsellor and a mental health professional.
