To celebrate the pious occasion of Guru Nanak Jayanti, students of Classes VI – X of Summer Fields School, Kailash Colony went to Gurudwara Sri Guru Singh Sabha ,G.K.-2 and Gurudwara Bala Sahib for ‘Sewa’ on 7th November, 2022.

Inspired by the Principal Ms. Geeta Karunakaran, our gregarious students volunteered to spend time at the Gurudwara. There they first learnt about the history and role of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, who was the founder of the Sikh religion. They were told about the three main tenets of the Sikh religion, which are as follows-

Kirat Karni - This means that one should do honest labour to earn one’s livelihood.

Wand Chhakhna – This tenet implies that one should share one’s food with others. So *langars* are regularly organized in the Gurudwaras.

Naam Japna – It says that one should remember God at all times. Guru Nanak Ji came-up with a new language called *Gurumukhi*.
