GRANDPARENTS DAY: The day was filled with happy faces and excitement. Games and a ramp walk were organised for the

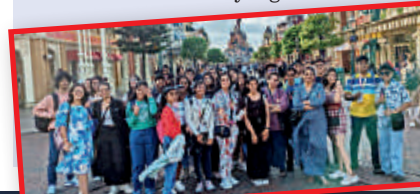


grandparents. The grandparents and their grandchildren together made a beautiful craft work.
