The last stretch of the Lecture was on the Modern Past of Japan and India, signifying in the varied cultures and diversity amongst the two countries, who were yet united by Modern Science.

Experiential learning....

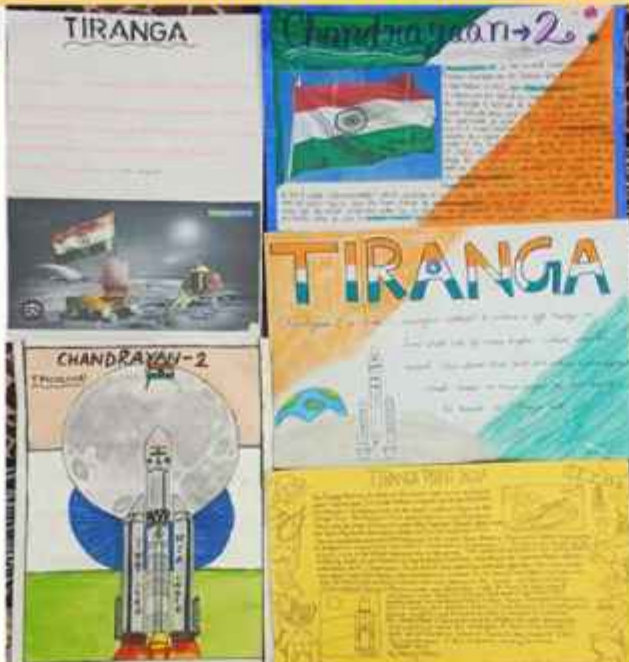

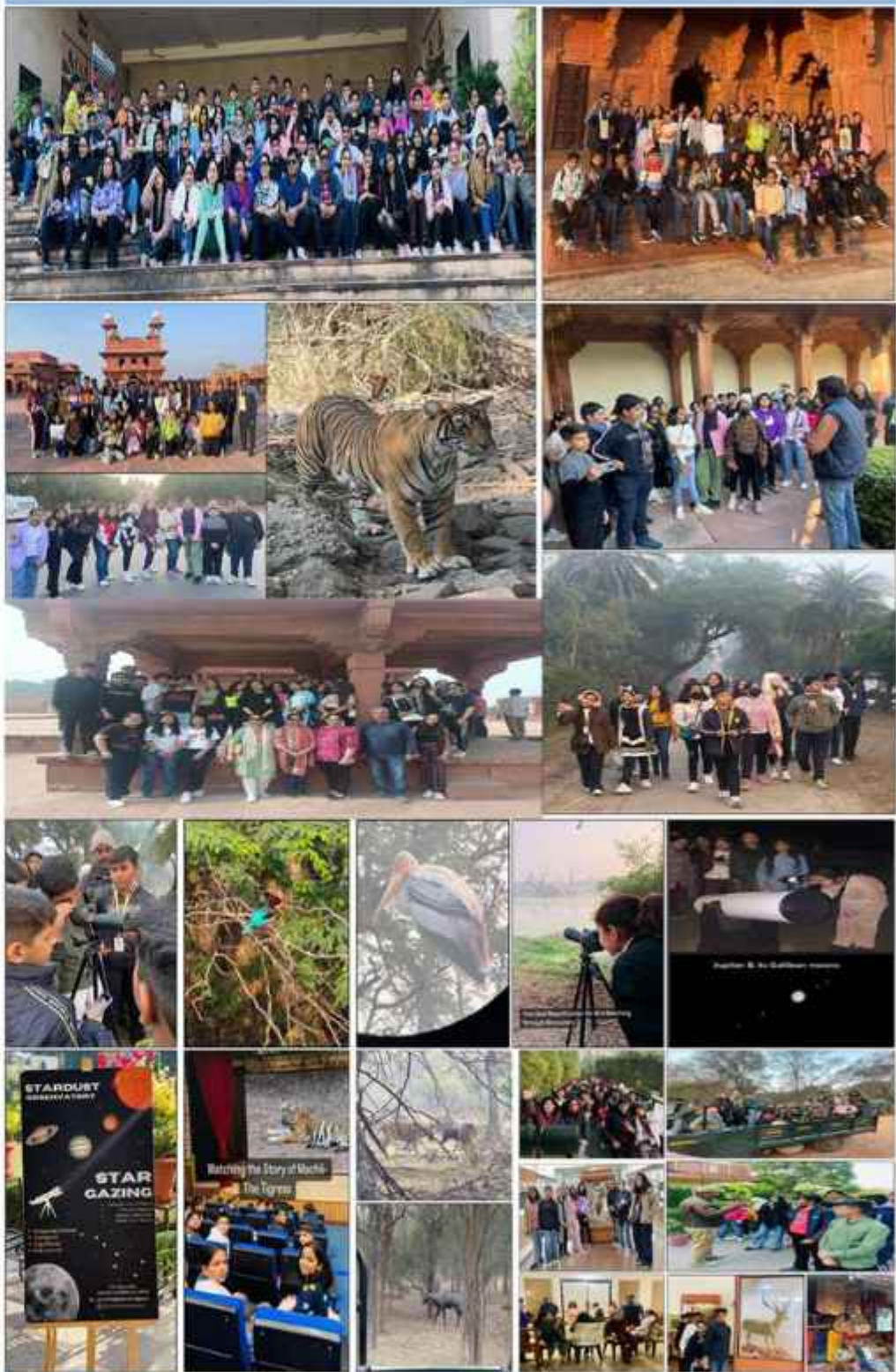
RANGMANCH - RECREATIONAL TRIP OF CLASS VI
