platform for attendees to explore educational options and engage with representatives from top universities.











# SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION



A civilization so advanced, it was believed to be invincible.


But as the winds stilled, it became nothing more than vestiges of the past.
