The Principal, Ms. Shalini Agarwal appreciated the initiative taken by the DOE and she also encouraged students to imbibe the learning that they have taken.



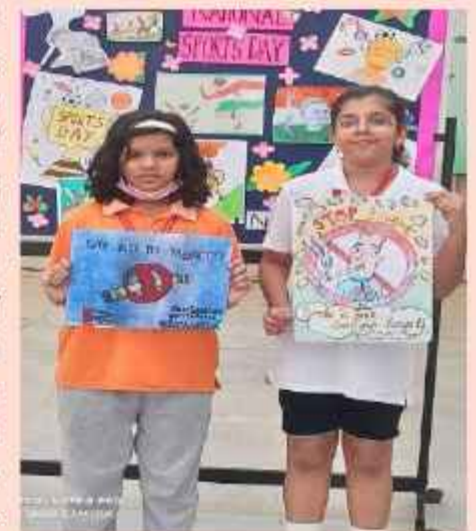
Going an extra mile.....

Our respected Principal, Ms. Shalini Agrawal, admired and encouraged the students to educate the masses and contribute to building a "TOBACCO FREE INDIA".

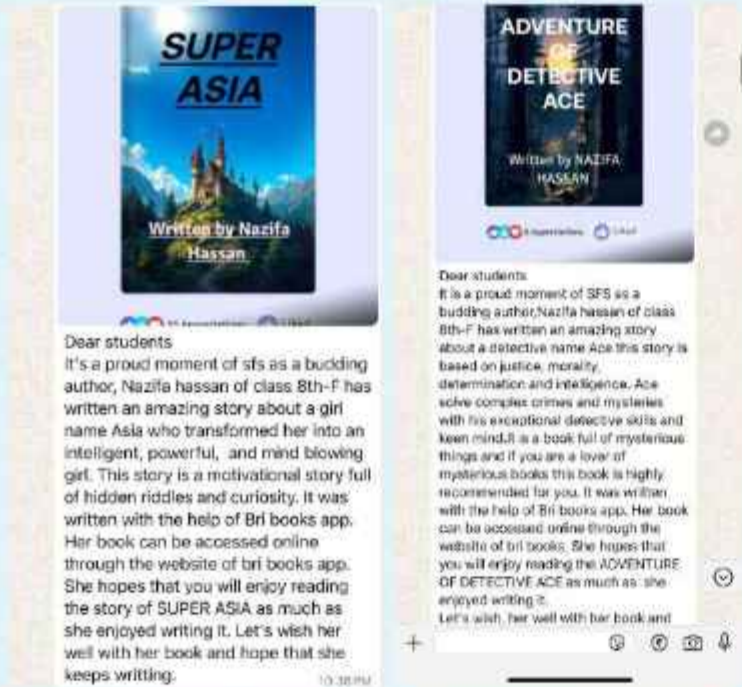


Our Budding Authors ...

इसका सम्मान इसे दिलाना।

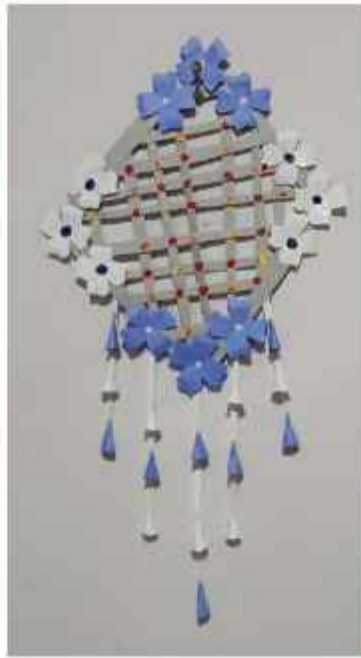
