Motivated by the visionary leadership of principal Alka Sahani, and mentored by Ruchi Sharma, Manasvi developed an eco-friendly alternative to conventional black plastic poly-thene pots. Her project creatively utilises peanut shells and natural binders to create biodegradable, agro-waste-based plant pots, offering a scalable solution that reduces plastic pollution and sup-
