The first trip involved 177 students from class XI & XII, accompanied by 19 teachers, from the 11th to the 13th. The second trip, from the 26th to the 28th, involved 102 students from classes IX & X, along with 11 staff members. Both excursions aimed to immerse students in the Pink City's rich heritage, culture, and architecture, providing a perfect blend of history, science, and fun.

The core activities across both three-day itineraries focused on Jaipur's most famous landmarks. Day 1 for the first group was dedicated to industrial heritage at Sangner's handmade paper unit, followed by a cultural evening at Chokhi Dhani. The second group, however, started by visiting the Albert Hall Museum and concluded with an evening at the modern Birla Temple and a DJ session.

Day 2 and Day 3 saw the groups converging on the city's royal and historical sites. Both groups extensively explored the majestic Amer Fort and the grand Maharaja's City Palace. Uniquely, the second group included an intellectually stimulating visit to Jantar Mantar, the astronomical observatory and UNESCO World Heritage Site, which provided a spectacular science-based learning experience, concluding their itinerary.
